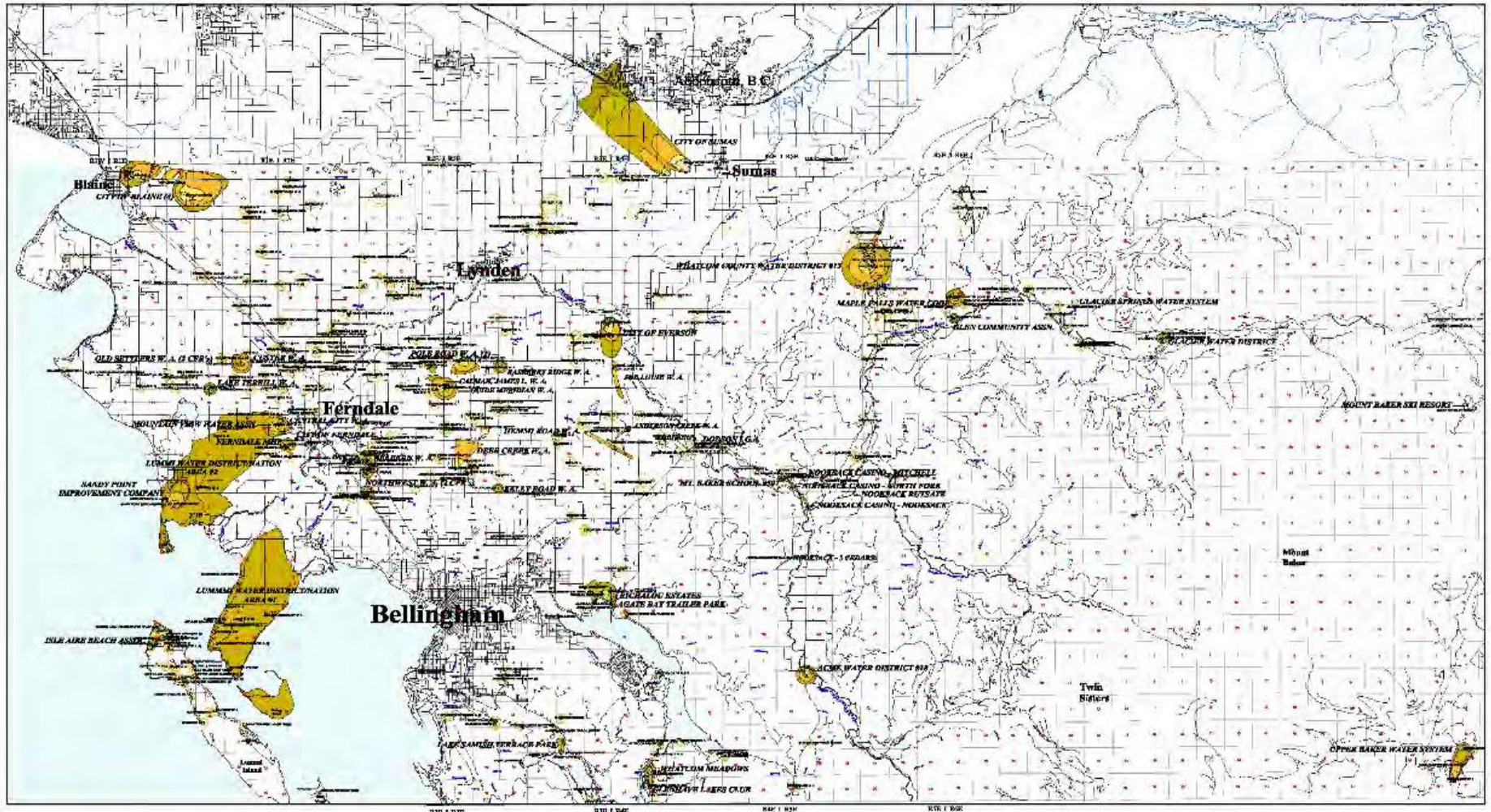


Wellhead Protection Areas



1. Wellhead Protection Areas (WHPAs) delineate the areas in which water is brought to town from the ground surface to the water source - based on flow. Methods shown include such as the following: Cultural Practices Basins (CPB), Analytical, Hydrogeologic Mapping, and Historical Flow/Usage Methods.

2. Wellhead Protection Areas are for Public Drinking Water Supplies that have a written plan (last updated as of 2/15/2007). Those systems that have not completed formal wellhead protection plans but have completed Unfinished Wellhead Basins Areas during their emergency vulnerability assessment also had those areas mapped around their wells. The remaining areas were protected by using the Voluntary CPB Method by WCDNR. All of the above wellhead protection areas are subject to annual land use planning processes.

3. Aerial data were provided via contract with a GIS (contract 1/26/2000) by CIMAS.
