Needs-Based Ferry Punch Cards – Changes Effective Oct. 4, 2015

All recipients must be current Lummi Island residents. Current fares: \$28 for 10 roundtrips for passenger/pedestrian and \$52 for 10 roundtrips for vehicle and driver.

Property Tax Exemption Reduced Fare Punch cards:

The process to qualify for needs-based punch cards based on a property tax exemption will not change. Applications are filed with and managed by the Whatcom County Assessor's Office and must be renewed at least every six (6) years or when income levels change. Valid photo identification must be presented each time when purchasing needs-based punch cards. Eligibility to purchase passes will be verified via the Assessor's website. If an application was approved the day of purchase, a copy is necessary to verify eligibility. If your name doesn't appear on the Assessor's website, you will not be sold a ferry pass and will be referred to the Assessor's Office.

Income Based Reduced Fare Punch cards:

Effective Oct. 1, 2013, <u>all</u> applications for needs-based punch cards based on income are obtained and processed by the Opportunity Council located at:

2016 HUD Very-Low Income Limits

\$48,400 or less for a family of eight

\$45,450 or less for a family of seven

\$42,500 or less for a family of six

\$39,600 or less for a family of five

\$36,650 or less for a family of four

\$33,000 or less for a family of three

\$29,300 or less for a family of two

\$25,650 or less for an individual

Proof of income for each household member over the age of eighteen (18) is required when the application is screened. Program eligibility must be re-evaluated every 12 months (a new application must be submitted to evaluate continued participation in the program.)

If the application is approved, a voucher will be provided by the Opportunity Council. Valid photo identification must be presented when purchasing needs-based punch cards. Voucher expiration dates will be verified each time prior to selling needs-based punch cards. If you do not have a current voucher, you will be referred to the Opportunity Council.
