## Construction Notice - Silver Lake Park Roadway and Auxiliary Parking Lot Improvement Project

Starting April 9, 2018 Whatcom County Parks & Recreation will begin reconstruction on the main entrance road and auxiliary parking lot. The construction will include road widening, and asphalt surfacing. The construction project is anticipated to be completed by June 22, 2018.

### What to expect:

- Temporary road closures
- Heavy equipment traffic
- Construction noise and vibration
- Flaggers will be on-site when necessary to insure safety of workers and visitors
- Restricted boat launch use
- Limited parking
- Intermittant shower facility closures

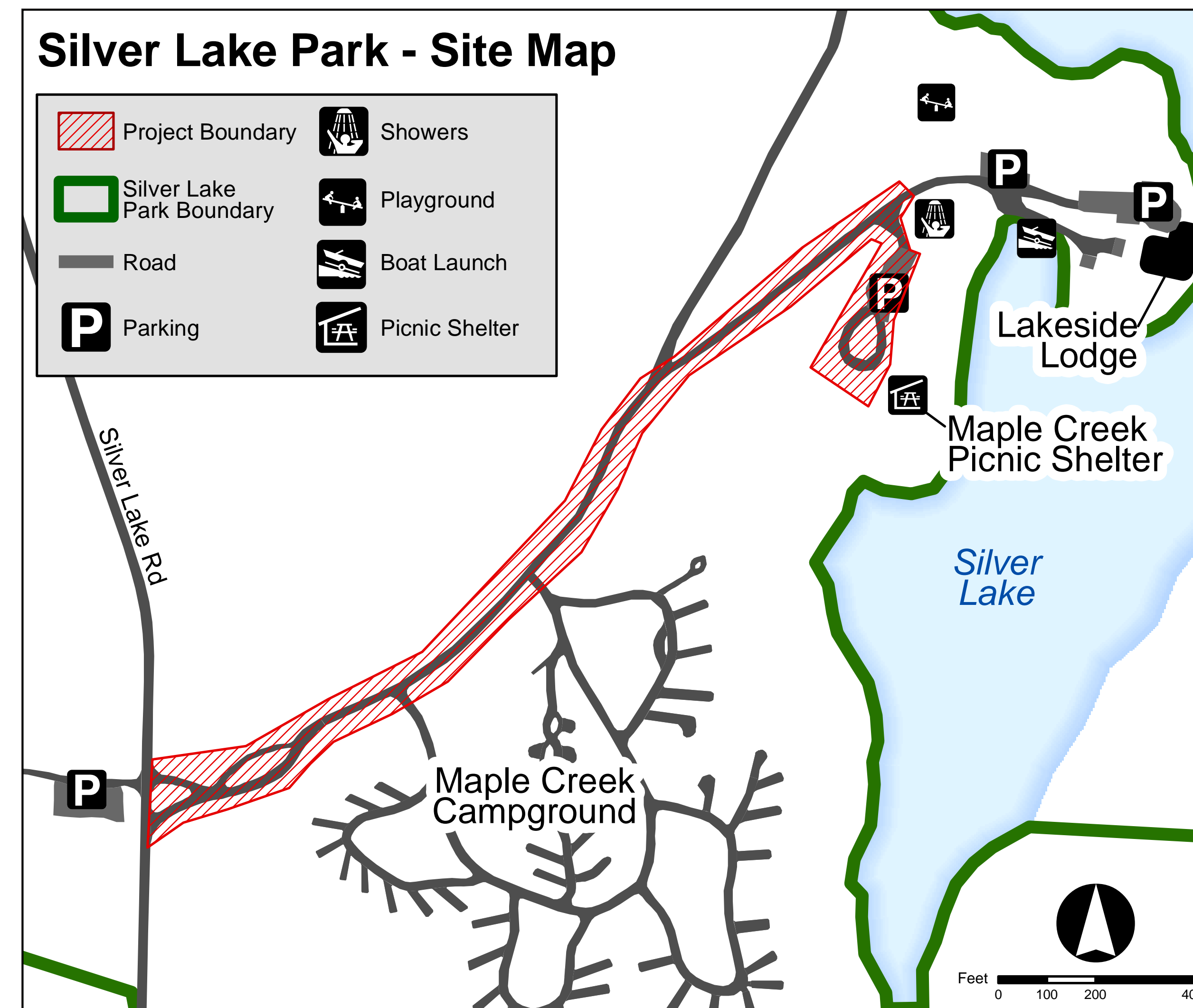
### Work Hours

### About the Project

- The roadway and parking improvement project at Silver Lake Park will include reconstruction of the main access road, restoring and widening road shoulders, installing drainage facilities and repaving the roadway. The auxiliary parking improvements near the shower and restroom facility consist of re-grading the parking lot, improving drainage, installing new asphalt paving, and improving accessibility to the restroom building and Maple Creek Picnic Shelter.

### Impacts to Boat Launch

The boat launch will be closed to the public Monday - Thursday beginning April 9, 2018 through June 22, 2018. The boat launch will be open to the public Friday - Saturday during that period, but with limited boat trailer parking availability.

Boaters are advised an alternative boat launch is available at the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW) facility at the north end of Silver Lake (Exit Park, turn RIGHT on Silver Lake Road, head north for 1.3 miles. Turn RIGHT on Camp Black Mountain Road, continue for 1,000 feet. Please note a Discover Pass is required).



### Impacts to Trails

During construction some park trails may be affected. Trails that cross, connect or are in proximity to work zones will be closed to public traffic. For your safety and the safety of construction workers, please do not enter trail sections that are closed. See map to the right for trail closures and alternate routes.
