Lummi Island Ferry COVID19 Change in Schedule

The Lummi Island Ferry is seeing declining ridership due to the COVID19 virus. In an effort to save fuel and give our crews more time to clean, the ferry we will be moving to the Dry Dock schedule. The Dry Dock schedule reduces a.m. runs from 21 to 15 and reduces the p.m. runs from 18 to 14. This change will be in effect beginning Monday, March 23, 2020.

Please know we are monitoring the ever changing conditions. Government mandates, and/or a continuing drop in ridership may drive us to revert to a weekend/holiday schedule. This schedule provides one run per hour with additional runs as needed. Should we revert to the weekend/holiday schedule, we will send an additional press release at that time.
