

*This number does not include 1 ACP (Address Confidentially Program) participant who is not in the election management system. Also one ballot envelope received credit even though it did not contain a ballot since it was not possible to trace back the "no ballot" to a particular voter.

An error occurred in processing two ballots where the voter voted for a candidate and also completed the arrow at the write-in position which would have resulted in an overvote for that race and not for the candidate(s) in question. This discrepancy was not discovered until after the original ballots had been counted. Two ballots were duplicated to correct this error and allow for the two candidates to receive the valid vote(s) for them. This resulted in the ballot counting equipment counting two more ballots than the number of voters receiving credit. The actual ballot count was 31,980 ballots processed. This is the reason for the discrepancy of 2 between ballots counted and voter credit.
