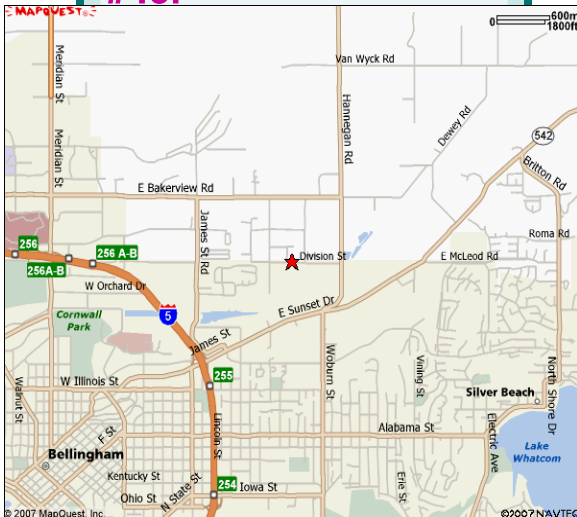


## How can you find us?

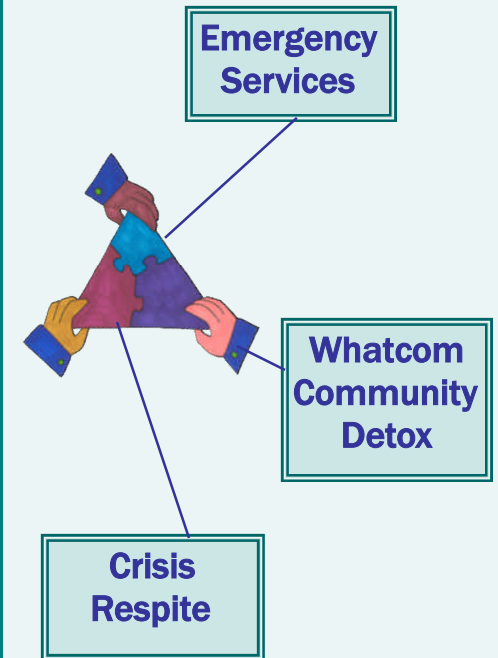

## Who are we?

We are a collaboration of different agencies in Whatcom County who have joined together to offer a number of different services.

The agencies involved are:

- ◆ Whatcom Counseling and Psychiatric Center
- ◆ Pioneer Human Services
- ◆ Whatcom County Human Services

The Triage Center is a voluntary facility. There is no charge for the services.

We operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays. Well trained, professional staff are available at all times.

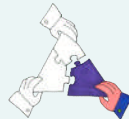

## What do we offer?



### **Emergency Services**

Emergency services workers (DCRs/DMHPs) provide contact to community members who need crisis intervention counseling, mental health crisis screening, crisis stabilization, assessment and referral to follow-up services when necessary.



### **Whatcom Community Detox**

A safe place where a person can get help from trained staff while detoxifying from alcohol/drug substances. People may spend up to 5 days in this program while recovering from the effects of intoxication and withdrawal.



### **Crisis Respite**

Short-term residence of up to 5 days for people experiencing a mental health crisis. Trained, professional staff provide crisis management, help with discharge planning and access to benefits, shelters and ongoing services.

## Who can use the Center?

You may use the Triage Center if you are:

- ◆ 18 years of age or older
- ◆ Having a mental health crisis
- ◆ Are intoxicated or in withdrawal from alcohol or other substances
- ◆ Able to be calmed down by others
- ◆ Willing and able to follow the house rules
- ◆ Are medically stable and don't need a doctor or medical care

## How do I get services at the Triage Center?

- ◆ Come to the Triage Center at any time of day, or
- ◆ You may be referred by your counselor, the hospital, the police or others, or
