**CONTINUING THE
SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLAN WORKING GROUP**

WHEREAS, Whatcom County offers supplemental plans to allow employees to save their own money for retirement and medical costs on a tax-deferred basis, and

WHEREAS, employees' funds are held in trust, and

WHEREAS, the service providers and the County share fiduciary responsibility to offer appropriate opportunities to employees to invest and access those funds, and


WHEREAS, the Administration wishes to continue the Working Group established in 2004 with revised membership to annually review participation, investment options, provider services, fees, and plan features, and to recommend actions and policy changes which may improve employees' retirement saving, and

WHEREAS, membership will consist of the following positions (or designees):

- Director of Administrative Services
- Human Resources Manager (serves as Chair)
- Finance Manager
- Civil Deputy Prosecutor, Prosecutor's Office
- Cash Management Administrator, Treasurer's Office
- Two employees, one near career entry and one at mid-career

NOW, THEREFORE, By virtue of the power vested in me by the Home Rule Charter for Whatcom County, I hereby rescind Executive Order 04-02 and continue the "Supplemental Retirement Plan Working Group" as revised.
