I, the undersigned permittee or agent thereof, certify that the information shown hereon is known by me and is true and correct and understand that the permittee shall be liable as set forth in R.C.W. 46.44.110 for all damages to any public highway, bridge or elevated structure, resulting from the movement of equipment authorized by this permit on the public highways of this County. The permittee shall further hold blameless and harmless and indemnify Whatcom County, its officers, agents and employees against any accident, liability, loss, injury, action and the costs thereof arising from the conductor operations of the permittee in connection with this permit. I further understand that prior to movements the permittee shall establish a routing to safely detour all structures having a limited clearance less than the permitted height.
