Emergency Service Outage for the Lummi Island Ferry

Whatcom County Public Works would like to inform the public that the Lummi Island Ferry will discontinue service today, Friday, October 21, 2016 after the 11:00 p.m. runs to perform an emergency repair to the docking system.

Accordingly on Friday, October 21, 2016 from 11:20 p.m. to approximately 7:00 a.m. the following morning, the Whatcom Chief will not be in service. It is anticipated that the ferry will be back to its regular schedule on Saturday, October 22, 2016. However, the ferry cannot resume runs until after this emergency repair is complete. Therefore, the first runs of the day may be delayed.

The 11:00 p.m. run from Lummi Island and the 11:10 p.m. run from Gooseberry Point will be the last runs this evening. Due to the complex nature of these repairs there will not be any exceptions or additional runs after the posted last run times.

The Public Works Department would like to thank everyone in advance for their cooperation and patience during these emergency repairs.
