Notice of February 11, 2020 - Special Election

Individuals can now register to vote or update their registration information until 8:00 pm on Election Day by appearing in person at the Whatcom County Auditor's Office.

Registration Deadlines: If registering to vote online or by mail – or – if changing your address online or by mail, the Auditor's Office must receive the information by February 3rd to be eligible to vote in the February 11th Special Election. Register to vote or change your address at VoteWA.gov.

Citizens that miss the February 3rd deadline can still register to vote or change their address but must appear in person at the Whatcom County Auditor's Office, 311 Grand Ave., Suite 103, Bellingham, by 8:00 pm Election Day.

The election will be conducted entirely by mail and ballots will be mailed to all registered voters at their mailing address on record.

Voters Requiring Assistance & Other Information: Voting assistance for elderly or disabled individuals is available at the Whatcom County Auditor's Office or call (360) 778-5102. We gladly accept relay calls. Election and voter registration information, registration forms, and election ballots are also available at the Auditor's Office.
