Greetings Stakeholders and Community Members,

We know it has been some time since we last updated you on the [South Fork Nooksack River Fish Camp \(Ts'eq\) Reach Integrated Design Project](#). We apologize for the delay in providing an update since our last update on February 1, 2021 after the January 26, 2021 community workshop. Since the last community workshop, the project team used feedback from participants at the workshop to develop a preferred alternative and preliminary design. We look forward to updating you on the design progress at the next upcoming community workshop soon - stay tuned for a save the date!

In the meantime, we are asking you to fill out a [brief online poll](#) to share your individual experiences with flooding. We imagine many of you were, or have neighbors who were, impacted by the November 2021 flood events. We would like to incorporate these recent experiences and observations into our hydraulic modeling and use them to better inform the community needs into the design process. Along with a handful of questions regarding your unique experiences during the November 2021 flood event, this poll incorporates an interactive Google map. The purpose of this map is for you to show us specifically where you observed the impacts of flooding on your property and/or throughout your community. You will be able to access the map via a link within the online poll.

To use the map,

1. Create a new layer with the closest address or milestone for your observation
2. In the Top/Middle of your screen, use the markers and/or "draw a line" tool to create shapes or lines to label the exact location of your observation
3. Include a description with the label with as much detail as possible
