The Jones Creek Debris Flow Risk Reduction Project

The Whatcom County Flood Control Zone District (FCZD) has designed two earthen and rock berms to reduce the risk of Jones Creek debris flow hazards to the Community of Acme, WA.

Prior work included debris flow studies in 2004 and 2010, a roadway alternatives analysis in 2017, and several community meetings.

Construction is anticipated to start in spring of 2023.
